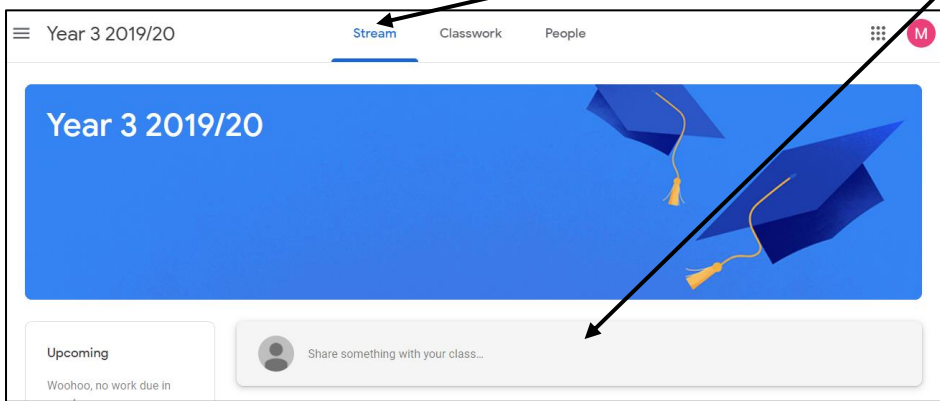
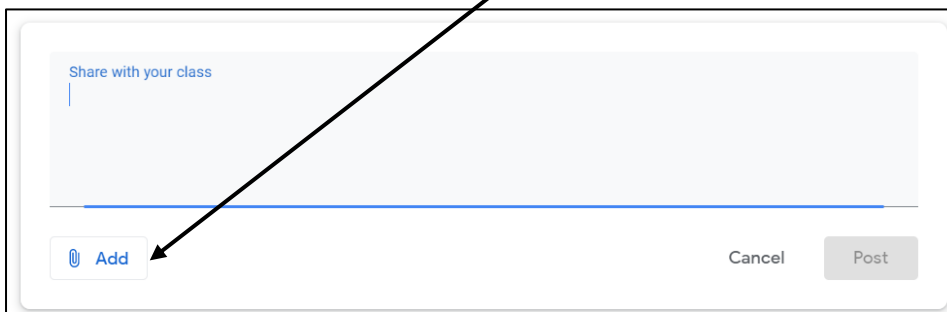


There are two ways a child can share their work to Google Classroom. The first way will let other children see their work. This is a good way to share work with friends and allows other children to comment on the work completed. To do this, follow the steps below.

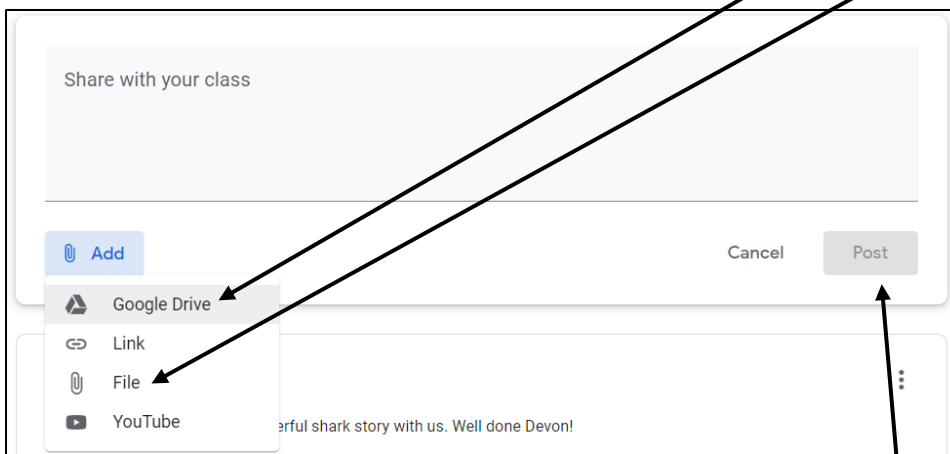
Step 1 – Sign in to Google Classroom, on the stream tab click on ‘share something with your class’.



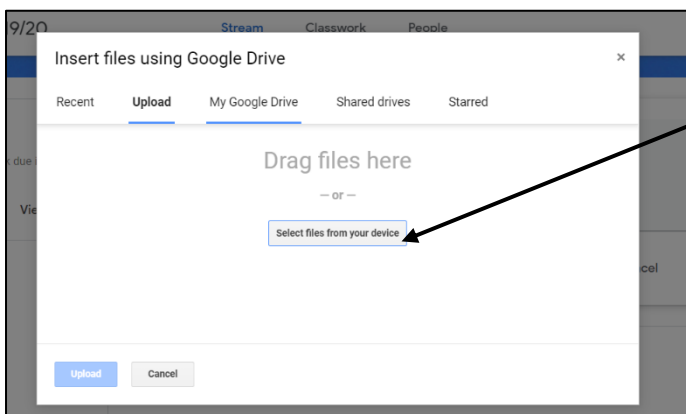
Step 2 – Write a comment and click the add button.



Step 3 – To find the file that you would like to share click Google Drive or File.

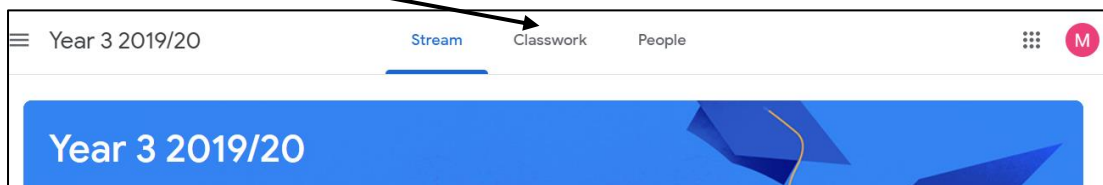


Step 4 – Find the file that you would like to upload. If it is on your computer, click ‘select from your device’. Then upload it and post the comment and work.

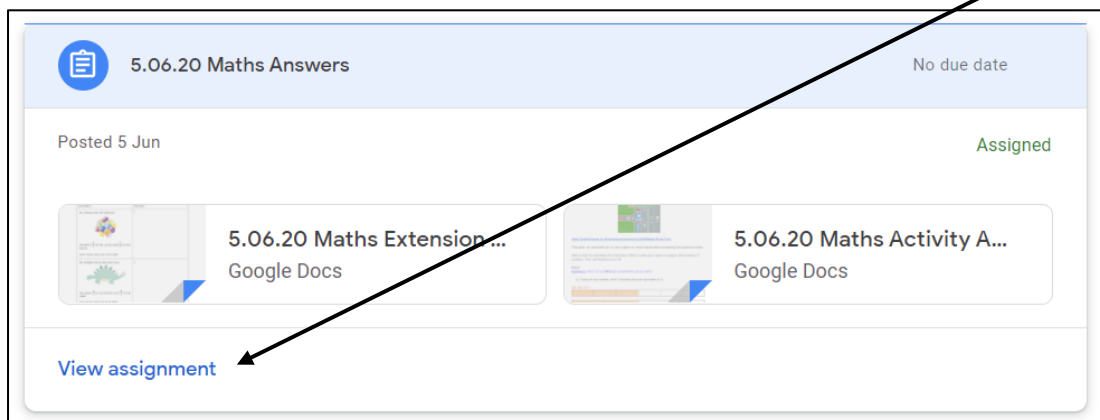


The second way to upload work will enable only the teacher to view it. This is a good way to share work and receive specific comments from the teacher.

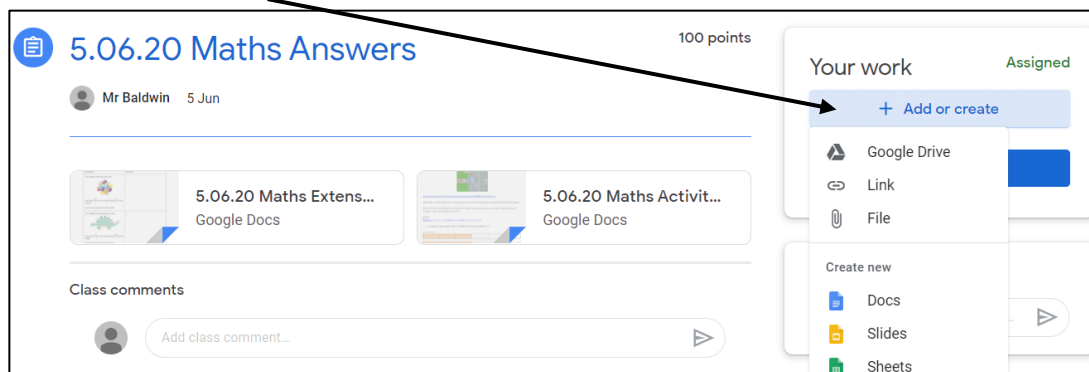
Step 1 – Click on the 'Classwork' tab at the top of the page.



Step 2 – Find the assignment that you would like to attach the file to and click 'View Assignment'.



Step 3 – Click 'Add or create'. Then choose either 'Google Drive' or 'File'



Step 4 – Find the file that you would like to upload. If it is on your computer, click 'select from your device'. Then upload it and post the work to the teacher.
