Why did you like it? Why would you recommend it to other children in the class?</p> 	<p><u>Writing</u></p> <p>Keep a diary about your days at home. Try to include the features we have learnt about in class such as, writing it in first person and including informal language and opinions. If you want to make it more exciting, make up some fun things and add them in.</p> 	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Practise your mental maths by creating a maths hopscotch. This could be how they lived, what they ate, what they used stone/bronze/iron for?</p> <p>Take the information you have found and create a poster all about the period of time you have chosen.</p> 	<p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>In Art your task is to research an artist. Once you have done this, use the information you have found to make an information page about them on a Google Doc.</p> <p>Add word art, images and text and arrange them on the page so it looks well organised and exciting.</p>	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>Research an artist of your choice and recreate one of their pictures. Think about the materials and techniques they have used carefully.</p>
