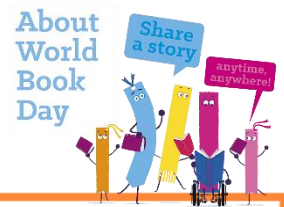


World Book Day 2021

FREE BOOK TOKEN!!

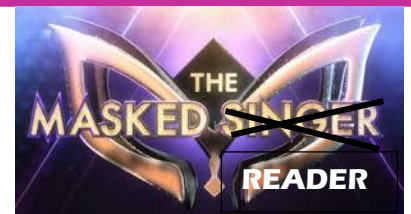
