




## Year 3



### Spring 2 - What's your Perspective?

**As writers we will** be creating our own alternative forms of fairy tales, and then moving on to writing reports all about physical and human geographical features. As well as this, we'll be continuing to learn and practice our spellings.

**As readers we will** be reading Cinderboy and The Wolf's Story, both of which are alternative versions of traditional fairy tales. Cinderboy is a story about a boy's dream to play for his team at the Cup Final. It looks doubtful – but will his fairy godmother save the day?

**As scientists we will** be learning how to work scientifically by classifying, making observations, learning how to do a fair test and draw our own conclusions from evidence.

**As mathematicians we will** continuing to calculate with money. After this, later in the half term, we'll learn read and create different types of graphs before moving on to measuring lengths and perimeters. We'll also be continuing to learn our times tables.

**As geographers we will** be exploring our local area, using fieldwork to observe, measure, record and present the human and physical features using a

**As artists we will** be developing our art and design techniques through sculpture. We will be making our own sculptures based on "The Singing Bones" by Shaun Tan.

**As thinkers we will** be developing our understanding of Christianity and looking at why is the Bible so important for Christians today.

**As linguists we will** be developing our French language by learning how to talk about animals, ourselves and numbers. We will do this through drama, games and discussions.
