

## Robinwood Questions and Answers:

- **Will there be a tuck shop and should my child bring any money?**

At present, Robinwood are not running a tuck shop and have not scheduled this into the programme. We would like to provide the children with an alternative 'tuck shop', where they will be offered a small bag of sweets, a packet of crisps and a hot chocolate. They will not need to bring money for this.

- **Should my child do a lateral flow test on the morning before leaving?**

Taking a lateral flow test is not a requirement of Robinwood at present. We would recommend that you continue to follow government guidance should your child display symptoms. We will share further information regarding COVID guidelines shortly.

- **My child is not a confident swimmer. Will they be able to take part in activities?**

For water activities, all children will be required to wear a life jacket. The water is shallow enough to stand in too.

- **What food will my child be offered for lunch and dinner?**

At every meal time there will be a variety of choices, including vegetarian options and Robinwood can cater for specific dietary requirements. We will communicate these directly with Robinwood staff based on the information on the medical forms. There will always be fruit and other snacks throughout the day.
