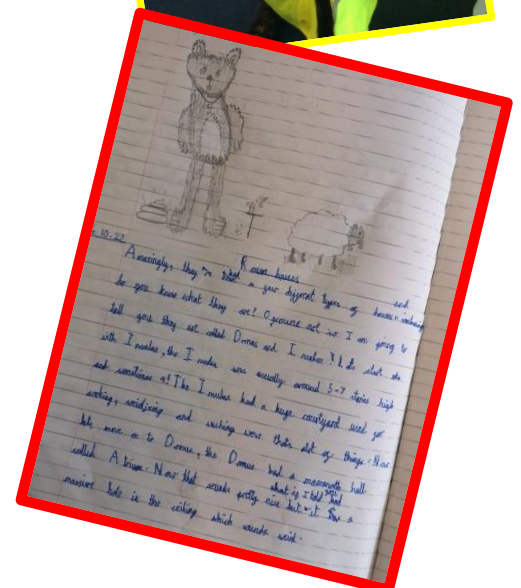

Lower Key Stage 2 (Year 3&4)

Year 4 have been writing a non-chronological report about the Romans this week after finding out lots of information about them. They have also enjoyed playing games in maths to practice their rounding skills as well as doing lots of times tables practice.





Upper Key Stage 2 (Year 5&6)

Year 5 have been writing an explanation text entitled 'How to care for a Minotaur'. They analysed the structure of the text type and its key features and thought carefully about how to structure theirs. Their writing so far has been fantastic!

Year 6 completed the York Museum Trust World War I walking tour this week. They learnt about the impact of The Great War on York and its citizens, including stories of war horses, wounded soldiers, enemy aliens at York Castle and conscientious objectors at York Mansion House.
