Early Years & Key Stage 1 (Year 1&2)

Early Years have enjoyed their PE session this week and learnt lots of different tag games while learning the importance of teamwork.

Year 1 have continued their artwork and their self portraits in the style of Giuseppe Arcimboldo. They look very impressive.

Year 2 have created animal pencil pots using clay. They used the score and slip method brilliantly!

Lower Key Stage 2 (Year 3&4)

Year 3's music has been focusing on the Samba style. Children really enjoyed listening to and moving to the rhythmical samba sounds and learned a call and response samba song.

Year 4 have been designing a 3D castle in DT. They are planning to add a switch so that the castle can light up the reading area.

Upper Key Stage 2 (Year 5&6)

Year 5 have been revising the capital cities of the UK this week in Geography. They also learned about different land use now and in the past.

Year 6 have absolutely loved their science this week, analysing and dissecting. They learned all about the inner workings of the hearts and had an amazing time doing it! Check out the size of the ox heart!



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Local Governing Committee Update

On Wednesday governors were invited into school to be a part of the annual peer review day. This involves headteachers from other schools in the Pathfinder Multi Academy Trust (PMAT) observing lessons, reviewing books and speaking with some of the subject leads, pupils, parents and school senior leadership team. It was quite an intense and very thorough process. It was great to go into many different lessons and see so much great learning taking place. I especially liked witnessing the strong relationships which were so apparent between staff and pupils, how well staff knew and understood pupils' individual needs and how comfortable pupils felt in their classrooms.

Learning about the computing curriculum was especially eye opening. Many of the year groups were learning things I think plenty of adults wouldn't be able to do: stop motion animation, recording podcasts, programming crumbles, 3D printing and building websites. This is obviously giving pupils a great foundation for the increasingly digitally-driven world they will one day be working in.

We also had an LGC meeting this week which included a focus on Early Years and approval of next year's budget.
